LPFM stations frequently do not need an interface to a character generator or LED message sign, both standard features in the EAS 911D, which lists for \$1,995.00. The EAS 911D/S still offers a rich array of professional features including two built-in, digitally tuned receivers, a 51-key front panel with LCD, “Practice” key, balanced audio output, built-in speaker, and two relay outputs. The EAS 911D/S is based on the TFT EAS 911, a market leader in broadcast, cable, and emergency management markets for over eight years.

LPFM stations wishing to add a printer or 4-port COM expander at a later time may do so. Both items are plug-in and easily installed by non-technical personnel.
